ROVANPERÄ AND A LENINGRAD COWBOY HEAD TO MEXICO

Harri Rovannerä, who competed in the World Rally Championship from 1993 to 2006, will join this year's La Carrera Panamericana rally in Mexico. Harri is driving a 1954 Studebaker in Turismo Mayor class. In 2010 the rally starts from Tuxtla Gutierrez on October 22nd and finishes in Zacatecas on October 28th.

La Carrera Panamericana (1950-1954), was one of the most famous events in auto racing history. The event was revived as a "stage" rally in 1988 and for twenty years has offered both the experienced racer and the novice an opportunity to experience the thrills and challenges of the original Pan Am, the most difficult road race in the world. Each year one hundred cars line up in southern Mexico to race more than 2000 miles to northern Mexico. The event passes through the heart of the country, marked by a glorious string of mountains and quaint colonial cities. Along the way the drivers will be cheered on by thousands of spectators.

Sakke Järvenpää, the founding member of the world famous rock band Leningrad Cowboys will also attend the rally in 2010. Last year Sakke participated in the rally with his 1958 Corvette, this year he will drive a 1965 Ford Mustang Fastback in Historic C class.
